Expectations/Commitment of Steering Committee Members

- Attend monthly 1 ½-hour Steering Committee meetings.
- Participate on the Steering Committee with a collaborative approach, focusing on client-centered care, long-term change, a common vision and agenda, and shared information to improve service system performance.
- Serve as content expert and advise on the Initiative planning and activities.
- Provide brief presentation during a Steering Committee meeting regarding your or your agency's mental health services referral and service delivery process.
- Provide information and insight from one's area of expertise and agency regarding care coordination, including best practices.
- Participate on a subcommittee for up to 6 hours over the course of the project as needed and as able.
- Assume a communication role between one's agency and the Initiative Steering Committee and assist in the development of a coordinated communication plan for the Initiative.
